The Call

Macedonia Baptist Church (MBC) of Arlington, Virginia seeks a visionary and spiritual leader, called by God to serve as Senior Pastor. This full-time position requires a strong pastoral leader to guide, to minister and cast the vision in our journey of spiritual growth and discipleship.

About Macedonia Baptist Church

Organized in 1908, MBC is a family-oriented, spirit-filled church with a long tradition of having strong teaching, preaching and music ministries. We are committed to following Jesus Christ, worshipping Him with hearty praise and thanksgiving. We continue to seek wisdom from God through weekly Bible Study, Sunday School and Worship.

MBC is located in South Arlington, Virginia, in one of Arlington's oldest African American communities, known as Nauck, dating back to 1844. MBC has established community partnerships and is actively engaged in developmental projects with a rapidly growing and diverse community.

MBC is governed by the Bible and Constitution and By-laws. MBC is affiliated with the National Baptist Convention, USA, Inc. and the National Church Usher's Association.

Responsibilities of the Pastor

The Senior Pastor will serve as the spiritual leader of MBC and will be responsible for leading, overseeing, and attending religious activities. The Senior Pastor will guide members of the Ministerial staff, the Deacon Ministry, the Deaconess Ministry and Minister of Music in conducting religious services and ordinances as well as providing pastoral care.

The Senior Pastor is also charged with promoting and supporting the spiritual growth of MBC's multi-generational membership. Consistent with federal and state regulations, MBC's Constitution and By-laws, and the Trustee Ministry, the Senior Pastor will directly lead the church staff; moderate church business meetings; and administer church programs and initiatives. Additionally, the Senior Pastor will provide marital and grief counseling, officiate weddings, eulogize funerals, and represent the church in public forums.

Required Professional Qualifications:

- A licensed minister, preferably within the Baptist tradition.
- Post-secondary Biblical or Seminary Degree from an accredited theological school or a school accredited by the Association of Theological Schools in the United States and Canada.
- At least five (5) years of pastoral experience either as a member of a ministerial staff or serving as a congregational pastor.
- Proven speaking, preaching and oratory skills.
- Ability to direct and manage the work of staff with varying levels of capacity
- Ability to motivate and inspire across generations and cultures.
- Competency with Microsoft Office applications and email management tools.
- Excellent verbal and written communication and interpersonal skills.
- A courteous, compassionate and respectful demeanor.

Preferred Skills and Experience:

Demonstrated knowledge or formal training in the following areas are highly preferred:

- Leading ministry within a culturally and economically diverse environment;
- Counseling (grief, marriage, substance abuse, etc.);
- Youth (ages 0-17) and Young Adult (18-35) ministry;

Semi-finalists will be asked to interview with the Pastoral Search Committee in person as well as provide: (1) copies of ministerial license and/or ordination certificates; (2) copies of degrees, including any educational training and/or classes; (3) three references; and (4) links and/or recordings of sermons within the past 12 months. Finalist will be asked to visit MBC for a trial sermon during a worship service and teach Bible Study. Successful completion of a background investigation involving credential evaluation, drug testing, employment history and reference checks are required before commencing employment at MBC.
