

NORTHSTAR MISSION CENTER DC

We are so glad to have you as our guest at NorthStar Mission Center DC. We are pleased to offer low-cost accommodations in a great location convenient to Northern Virginia and D.C. All efforts have been made for clean and safe lodging upon your arrival. We will be praying for your ministry while you're here. Below you will find some important details about your stay, so please read carefully.

FACILITIES & POLICIES

CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT

Check-in time is 3:00 p.m. Check-out time is 10:00 a.m. If you need to adjust these times, please make your request in advance to be sure we can accommodate your arrival/departure times.

PARKING

Ample parking for cars and buses is available. See link to parking lot map for details.

DORM ROOMS

Four dorm rooms are available for housing purposes. There are 28 bunk beds, which can accommodate 56 people. When not in use by interns, there is also one room available for chaperones that has two sets of bunkbeds. (Chaperones only; no students.)

We provide towels, sheets, blankets and pillows. Please refrain from bringing food and drinks into the dorm rooms.

SHOWERS

There is one communal shower room consisting of 6 private shower stalls. Groups can schedule shower times for males and females accordingly. Showers are located down the main hall of the building. Bathrooms with sinks and toilets are located just down the hall from the dorm rooms. Please plan to carry toiletries to and from the showers each day.

KITCHEN/DINING AREA

A continental breakfast can be provided each morning you are staying with us if arrangements are made in advance. (Please note: there will be an additional fee for breakfast.)

The kitchen is available to prepare meals and store food. The adjacent dining area seats 60.

The kitchen and dining area must be cleaned and returned to their original condition after each use. Our kitchen is a standard kitchen stocked with basic pots, pans and cooking utensils. A microwave, toaster, toaster oven, coffee makers and Keurig are available. (K-cups are not supplied.)

We ask that groups provide their own disposable plates, cups, cutlery, etc. A refrigerator and food storage space designated for your group will be accessible at all times.

If there is more than one group staying at the same time, please be considerate and share the space and kitchen supplies.

Kitchen cleaning guidelines are posted in the kitchen.

DINING ROOM/LOUNGE SPACE

The dining area can also be used for lounge/worship space. A TV is available for use and is conveniently transported from room to room on a rolling cart. If there is more than one group staying, please be considerate and share the space.

Feel free to take/leave books on the lending library shelf. Games are also available for use by groups. Please return games to the shelf when not in use.

Please pick up after yourself/group. **PLEASE NOTE:** All areas (including the dorm, kitchen/dining area, restrooms and other common areas) left unsuitable will result in a \$100 cleaning fee to your church or organization.

INTERNET

Internet is available for groups to use as needed. Wi-fi password will be available at check-in.

LAUNDRY

Laundry facilities are not available on site. The closest laundromat is Wash N' Dry located at 8411 Sudley Rd, approximately 0.5 miles away.

MANASSAS BAPTIST CHURCH SPACE

Because we share the building with Manassas Baptist Church (MBC), we can only offer the dorm rooms, our kitchen, dining area, the hall bathrooms near the dorm rooms and the shower rooms near the front entrance of the main building. The rest of the space in the building is heavily used during the week and on the weekends by other ministries. Please respect MBC's space by staying in our designated areas.

ANY TYPE OF SMOKING AND/OR CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED ON THE MBC GROUNDS.

INTERNS

At any given time, up to four interns may be living on site and working with the mission center and/or local churches. When they are available, they are happy to assist with any questions and/or minor help you may need. If an intern is unavailable, and a NorthStar staff person is not in the office, please contact Alex Christopulos at 703.909.9604 for assistance.

AGE LIMIT

Children who are 12 years old and younger are not permitted to be anywhere in the building without a parent or guardian present. We are not able to house children overnight who are under the age of 13.

TRANSPORTATION

The NorthStar Mission Center is accessible by 2 major airports: DULLES INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (IAD) - 18 miles REAGAN NATIONAL AIRPORT (DCA) - 32 miles

If you are planning to work in and/or visit D.C., the Metro is the easiest mode of transportation. It will take you just about anywhere in the Metro D.C./Arlington area. The nearest Metro station is the Vienna Metro Station, located at 9550 Saintsbury Dr, Fairfax, VA 22031, and is on the Orange line.
